## Arrival and accommodation

Linz is situated 180 km from Vienna and 140 km from Salzburg and can be reached easily by train or plane. If there is no direct flight available, we recommend booking flight to Vienna or Salzburg and take the train to Linz. Train schedule is available at: [www.oebb.at](http://www.oebb.at) Or book a connecting flight from Vienna to Linz, so you could avoid changing trains.

If you have not yet booked a connecting flight, you can travel Linz as follows:

### **Via Vienna**

There are regular bus transfers from Vienna Airport to the train station “Westbahnhof” where trains to Linz leave hourly. The travel time from Vienna “Westbahnhof” to Linz is approximately 1 1/2 to 2 hours. Train schedule is available at: [www.oebb.at](http://www.oebb.at)

### **Via Salzburg**

Bus Nr. 77, departing from the Salzburg Airport every fifteen minutes, takes you directly to the main train station in Salzburg. Trains to Linz depart hourly and the estimated travel time is approximately 1 1/2 hours.

### **From Linz Airport (Hoersching) to Hotel Sommerhaus**

Linz Airport is situated a few kilometers outside of Linz. Between 6 am and 7 pm a shuttle bus departs every full hour to the main train station in Linz (Monday to Friday). The cost is € 2,60 (tickets available in the bus) and the travel time is about twenty minutes. For information see <http://www.flughafen-linz.at> > Service > Anreise. In order to get to the university, take the bus to “Goethekreuzung” and change to tram line 1 or 2 in the direction of “Universität”, and get off at “Schumpeterstrasse” near the university. From there it is a five minute walk to the Hotel Sommerhaus vulgo Julius Raab Heim (in the same direction you are faced when exiting the tram). The Hotel Sommerhaus is a 13 story building with three flags on the top of the building.

Another (easier) alternative is to travel by taxi, either to the main train station of Linz (costs about € 23) or directly to the Hotel Sommerhaus vulgo Julius Raab Heim. (about € 27).

### **From the main train station to the university**

The most convenient way to get to the university or Hotel Sommerhaus is by taxi. However, the university can be also easily reached by public transportation. At the second level of the train station there is a tram stop for lines 1, 2 and 3 (tickets can be purchased for € 1.80 directly at each stop). Take line 1 or 2 in the direction to “Universität–Auhof”. Take tram line 1 or 2 in the direction of “Universität”, and get off at “Schumpeterstrasse” near the university.



From there it is a five minute walk to the Hotel Sommerhaus vulgo Julius Raab Heim (in the same direction you are faced when exiting the tram). The Hotel Sommerhaus is a 13 story building with three flags on the top of the building.

Double room 70,00 Eur (=35,00 Eur per person per night). We already booked double rooms for students and got 35 Euro as special rates. **ATTENTION:** The EU refunds 23 Euro per night per student.

In the Hotel Sommerhaus, you will have to possibility to get a **cheap dinner** meal in the Restaurant/Bar for 5,00 to 8,00 Euro.

Hotel Sommerhaus is a student dormitory and guesthouse. It is located next to the Johannes Kepler Universität Linz, about 5 minutes to walk. Bring your laptop with you to use the free internet access in the Hotel Sommerhaus.

### **PLEASE NOTE: What is covered by IP funds?**

- City tour, social events (like Mostbauer and final dinner)
- Transfer and entry: excursion to exhibition "The value of life" in Hartheim Castle
- 75% of travelling costs for incoming students
- 23 Euro of the 35 Euro room rent is paid by IP funds. Unfortunately, 8 Euro per night as well as lunch and dinner have to be paid by students themselves.
